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## THE SERVICES OF THE MIDLAND BANK

The Midland Bank provides many services for its customers and some of these are described below.

*Current Accounts* are conducted, upon which cheques can be drawn. A Statement is provided showing a record of the amounts paid in, the cheques drawn and the balance of the account at the date of the last transaction.

*Deposit Accounts* are opened, and interest is allowed on credit balances, subject to notice of withdrawal, at rates advertised from time to time.

*Advances*—The Bank advances money for a wide variety of business and private purposes.

*Standing Orders*—A customer may arrange for the Midland Bank to make regular payments on his behalf to the debit of his account for such items as insurance premiums, rent and club subscriptions. The trouble of writing cheques and letters is thus avoided. Business undertakings may arrange for the Bank to pay their monthly or quarterly accounts and salaries into the banking accounts of the recipients.

*Safe Custody*—Documents and other small valuables, in deed boxes or sealed parcels, may be left with the Bank for safe keeping.

*Night Safes*—For those who handle large sums of money after banking hours, night safes are available at over 750 branches of the Midland Bank for use when the Bank is closed.

*Foreign trade and travel.* The Midland Bank provides comprehensive services for those engaged in export trade or who travel abroad for business or for pleasure. The Overseas Branch is at 122 Old Broad Street, London, E.C.2, and there are travellers' departments at the West End Foreign Branch, 196a Piccadilly, W.1, and at the Poultry and Princes Street Branch, E.C.2. There are also provincial foreign branches at Birmingham, Bradford, Liverpool and Manchester. In addition, the Bank has a special Foreign Trade Information Department at the Overseas Branch, which collects information on markets, buyers and agents abroad. *All of this information and the services provided are available to customers through any branch of the Bank.* There are also offices of the Midland Bank on board the Cunard liners and at the airports.

*Wills and Trusts*—If you wish you may appoint the Midland Bank Executor and Trustee Company as executors or trustees of your Will, or as trustees of family trusts or settlements. By long experience and training the officials of the Company are equipped to manage your affairs with care, skill and sympathetic understanding. The Manager of any branch of the Midland Bank will give you further information if you need it and he will readily arrange for you to meet an official of the Company.

The Midland Bank has more than 2,100 offices in England and Wales and it is affiliated with the Belfast Banking Company Limited, with 86 branches in Northern Ireland, and the Clydesdale & North of Scotland Bank Limited, with 356 branches in Scotland. In addition, it has several thousands of agents in places abroad.
