Monday 8th July - Saturday 13th July SUMMER PAINTING COURSE for Members.

This course will be given by Pat Hare, who trained at Brighton College of Art and who has exhibited at the Royal Academy, Society of Graphic Artists, Society of British Artists and Young Contemporaries. She is a well known lecturer in many art subjects and gave a BBC series "Learning to Paint". The class will convene at Bampton Arts Centre at 10.30 am each morning to discuss the day's plans, which will depend on the weather. On fine days groups will go out into the country (and should therefore bring picnic lunches or plan to use the nearest pub). If the weather is wet Bampton Arts Centre will be used for still life and life drawing and lectures. Members must provide their own materials (any medium may be used) and this includes an easel if considered necessary.
