About Alaric Smith ...


Alaric has lived in Oxfordshire for nearly 40 years and recently took early retirement as a Retail Finance Director.

Infrastructure before housing



In 2021, property developers made up more than half of the large donations received by the Witney Conservatives.





Demand action on sewage


Alaric Smith is concerned about discharges like the one pictured (right) near Clanfield sewage works.

Liberal Democrat MP Tim Farron has introduced a Private Members' Sewage Discharges Bill that would provide for mandatory targets and timescales for the ending of sewage discharges into waterways and coastal areas.

It will also enhance the powers of Ofwat to monitor and enforce compliance with those targets and timescales, require water companies to publish quarterly reports on the impact of sewage discharges on the natural environment, animal welfare and human health, and require the membership of water company boards to include at least one representative of an environmental group.

This represents meaningful action to solve the problem, in contrast with the Conservatives letting water companies off the hook!




