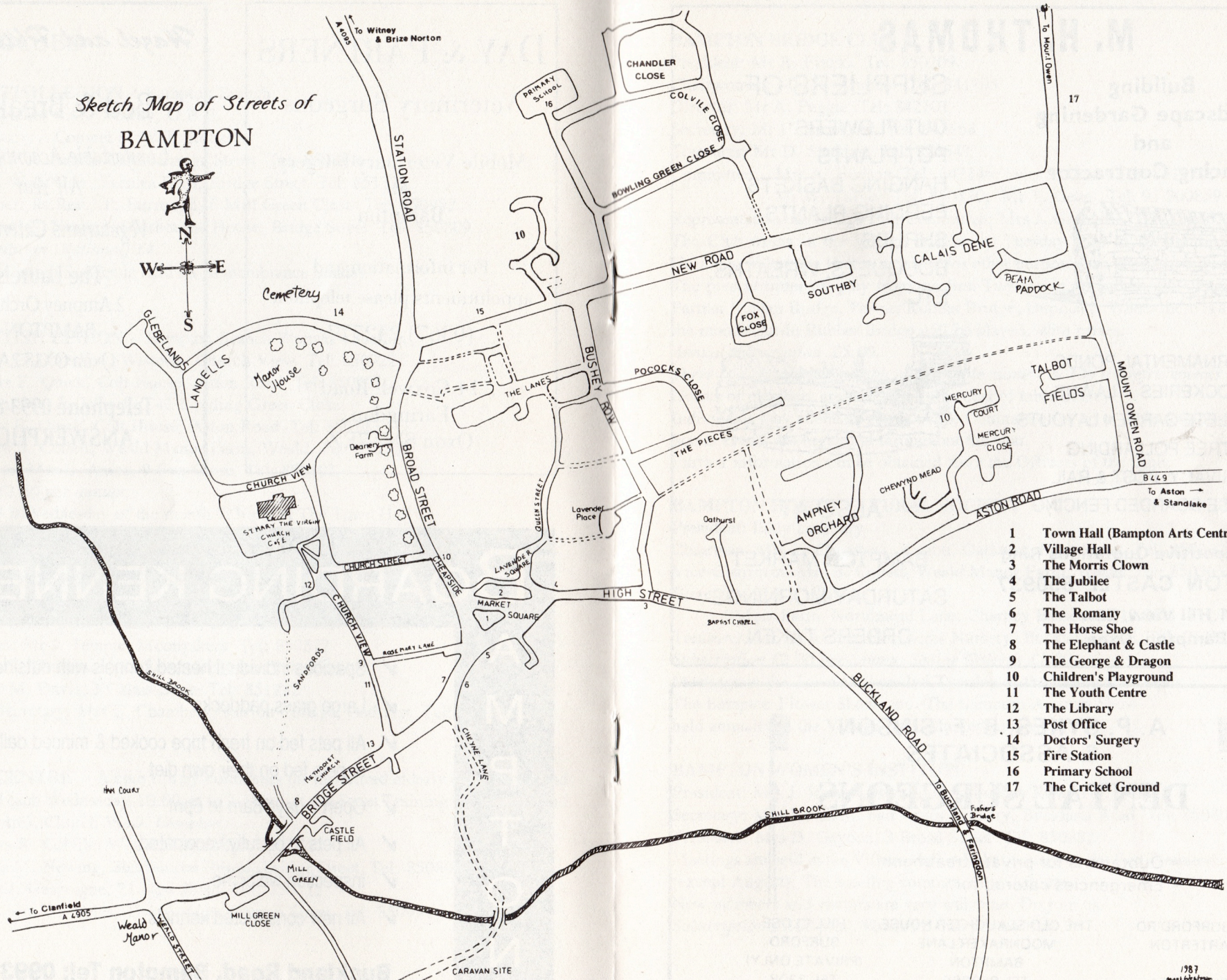

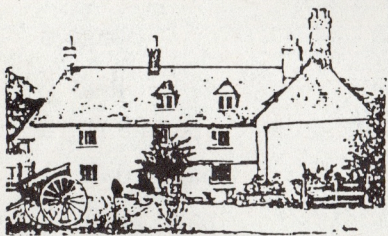
Sketch Map of Streets of BAMPTON
