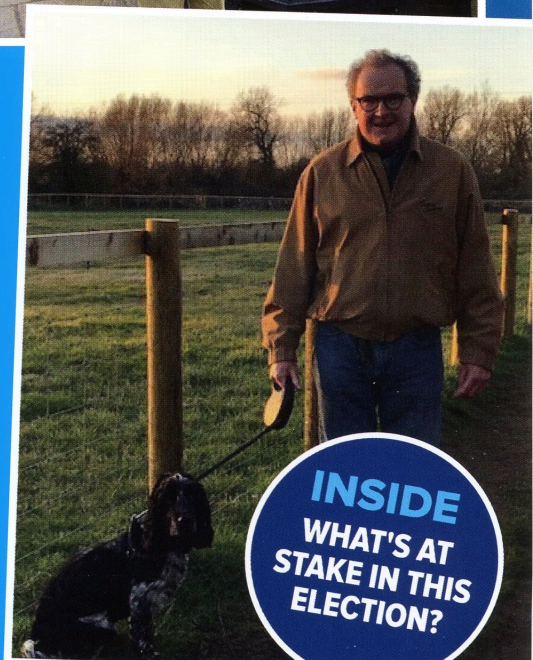
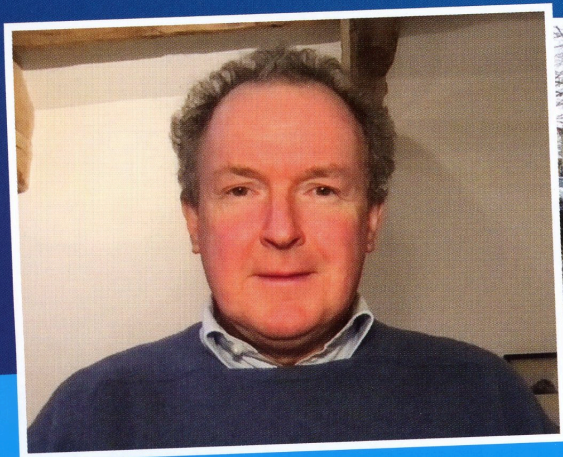

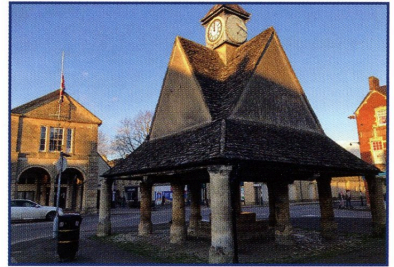

Creating a vibrant economy

Tackling isolation and improving wellbeing

The creation of a wellbeing hub, encouraging active travel and building outdoor gyms will bring our communities together to reduce isolation and improve people's wellbeing.
