

James Neal (1823 - 98)

The above photograph, taken circa 1860, shows James Neal, shoemaker of Bampton and husband of Charlotte Margaret White (1831 – 97).

On the reverse of the photograph is written 'Uncle James Neal. His wife was Charlotte Margaret, Aunt Lottie, White, your father's aunt. Lived Bampton.' It is understood that this was written by Margaret Ellen Beak (formerly Eeles), a great niece of Lottie Neal, to Betty Tremblin (formerly Eeles). Her father was Ebenezer Eeles, a great nephew of Lottie Neal.


