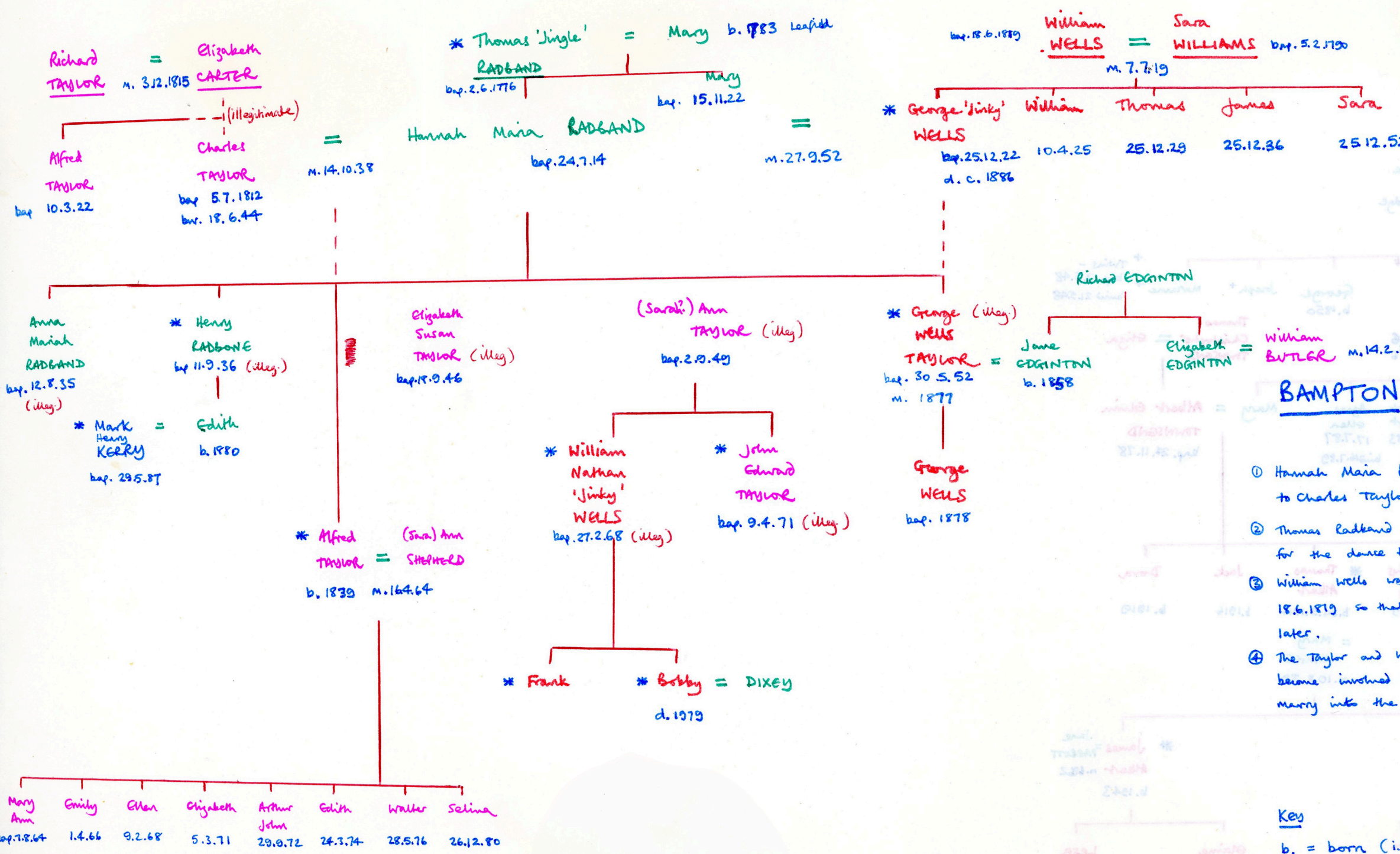

- ① Hannah Maria Radband married twice: to Charles Taylor, then George Wells
- ② Thomas Radband played the pipe and tabor for the dance team around 1800.
- ③ William Wells was presumably baptised on 18.6.1819 so that he could marry three weeks later.
- ④ The Taylor and Wells families only seem to become involved in the dancing when they marry into the Radband family.
