GENERAL REMARKS

1. **Situation :**

Bampton is situated about 14 miles west of Oxford and is approached either from the A40 through Witney (6 miles) or from the A420 through Faringdon (6 miles) and Clanfield.

The property is situated on the northern outskirts (A4095 to Witney) of this small town. Direction signs to the property will be erected.

2. **Viewing :**

All lots will be on view from 10.30 a.m. to 4.0 p.m. on Tuesday and Wednesday, 15th and 16th February, 1977, and on the morning of Sale from 9.30 to 10.30 a.m.

No viewing will be permitted during the progress of the Sale.

3. **Arrangements on Sale Day :**

The sale will commence promptly at 10.30 a.m. on Thursday, 17th February, 1977. All lots will be sold from the Catalogue in the Women's Institute Hall, situated in The Square at Bampton. **No lots will be shown during the Sale when the house will be closed.**
