In 1267, Burleigh Wood and Burleigh Meadow were granted to Godstow Manor by Henry III, but in 1274, the Farmer of Bladon claimed they belonged to his Manor. This land passed through a number of hands until sold to George Spencer, Duke of Marlborough in 1771. Burleigh Farm was built in about 1801, but the builders used earlier materials including a datestone of 1605. Purwell Farm which has identical plan to Burleigh was also built about same time using 16th century materials probably from demolished houses in Cassington by the Blenheim Estate. In 1665, part of the manor of Cassington belonged to Thomas Cheyne whose brass can be seen in the church. It passed through his family to John Gurnall, son of John Gurnall who then to Henry Alnutt. There were clothworks in Cassington in 16th, 17th & 18th centuries. The mill was acquired by Gurnall in 1651 & 1658, the miller was dead in 1691 and was also a clothworker. Rock Furlong took its name from rock used for drying fullled cloth.

Other village occupations:

- Carpenters, blacksmiths, tailors & a cordwainer.
- Cassington men supplied to and bought from Oxford Market in the 17th century and in the late 19th and in 20th century, carmen carts came from Cassington twice a week.
- The Electricity supply was connected in 1934.
