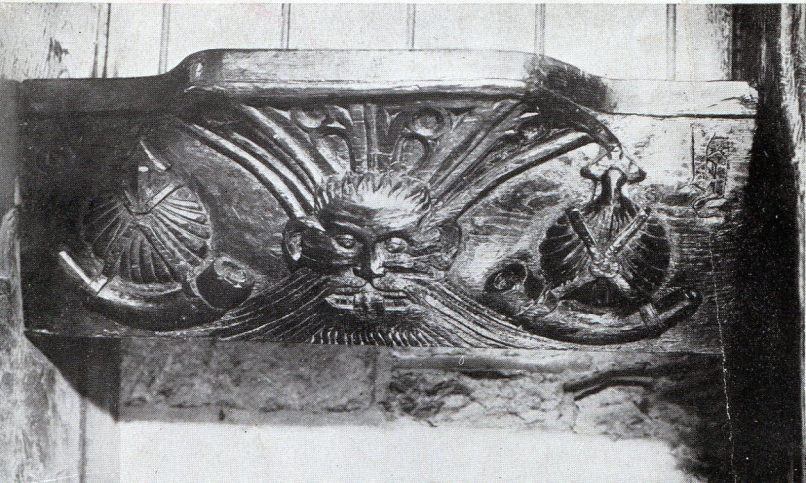
















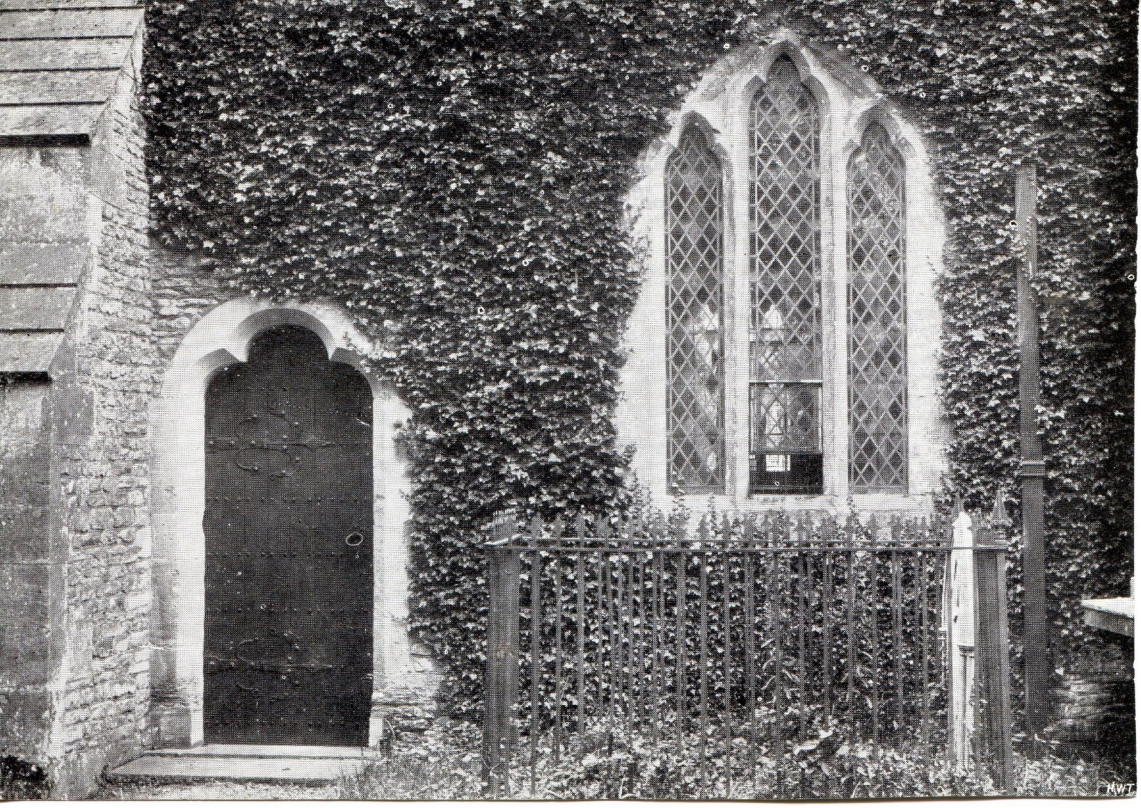




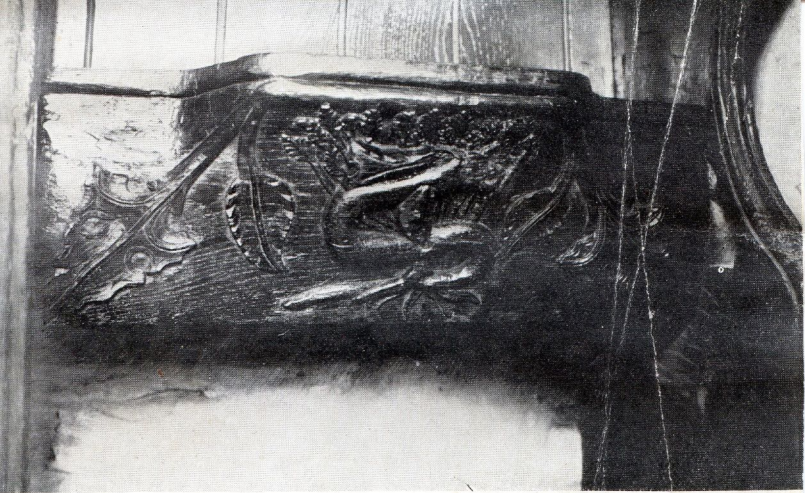








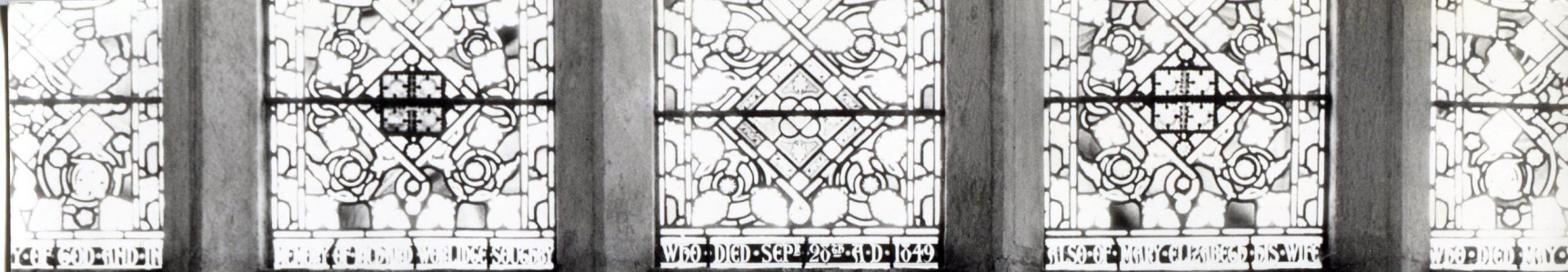




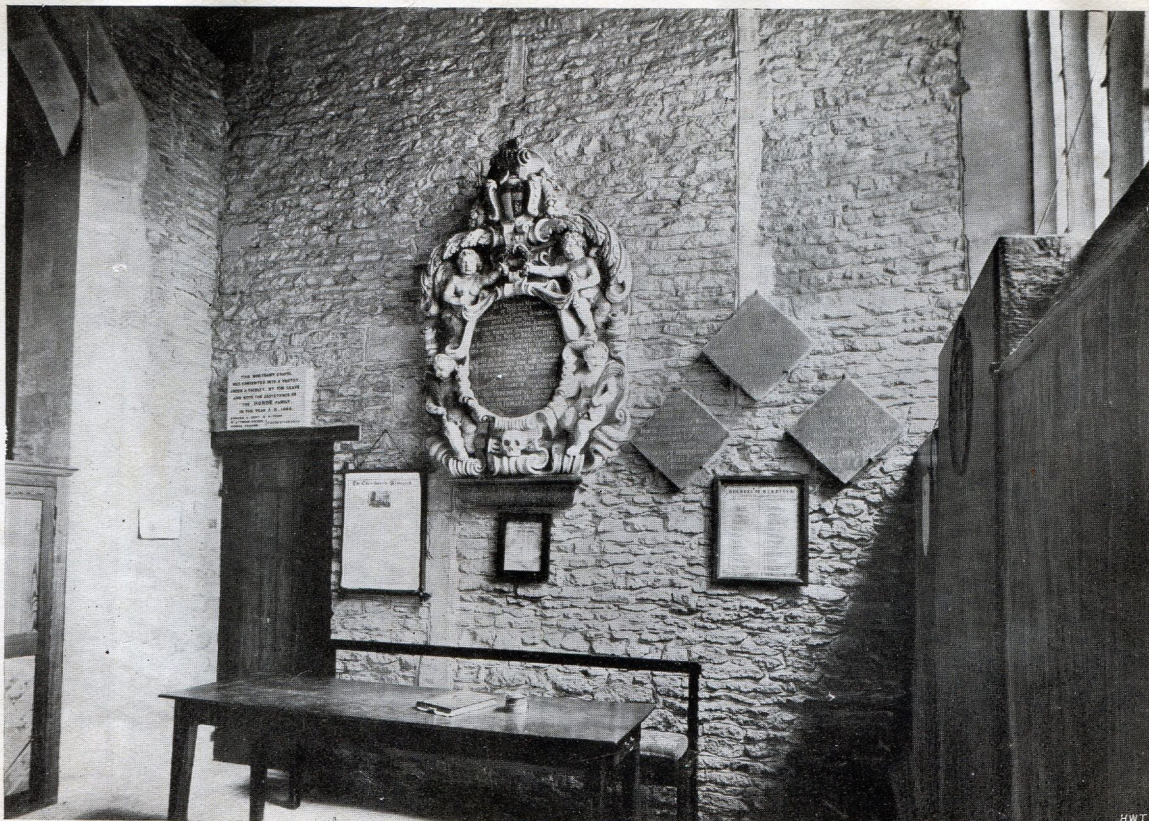


On the wall to the left of the door

1632









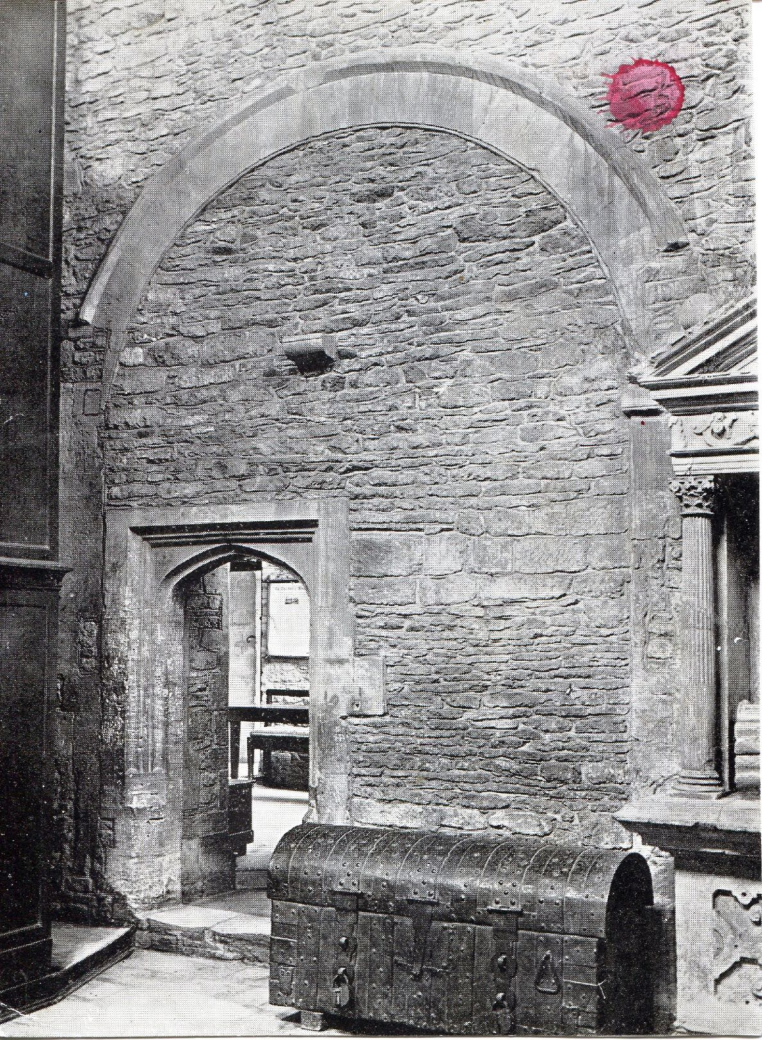

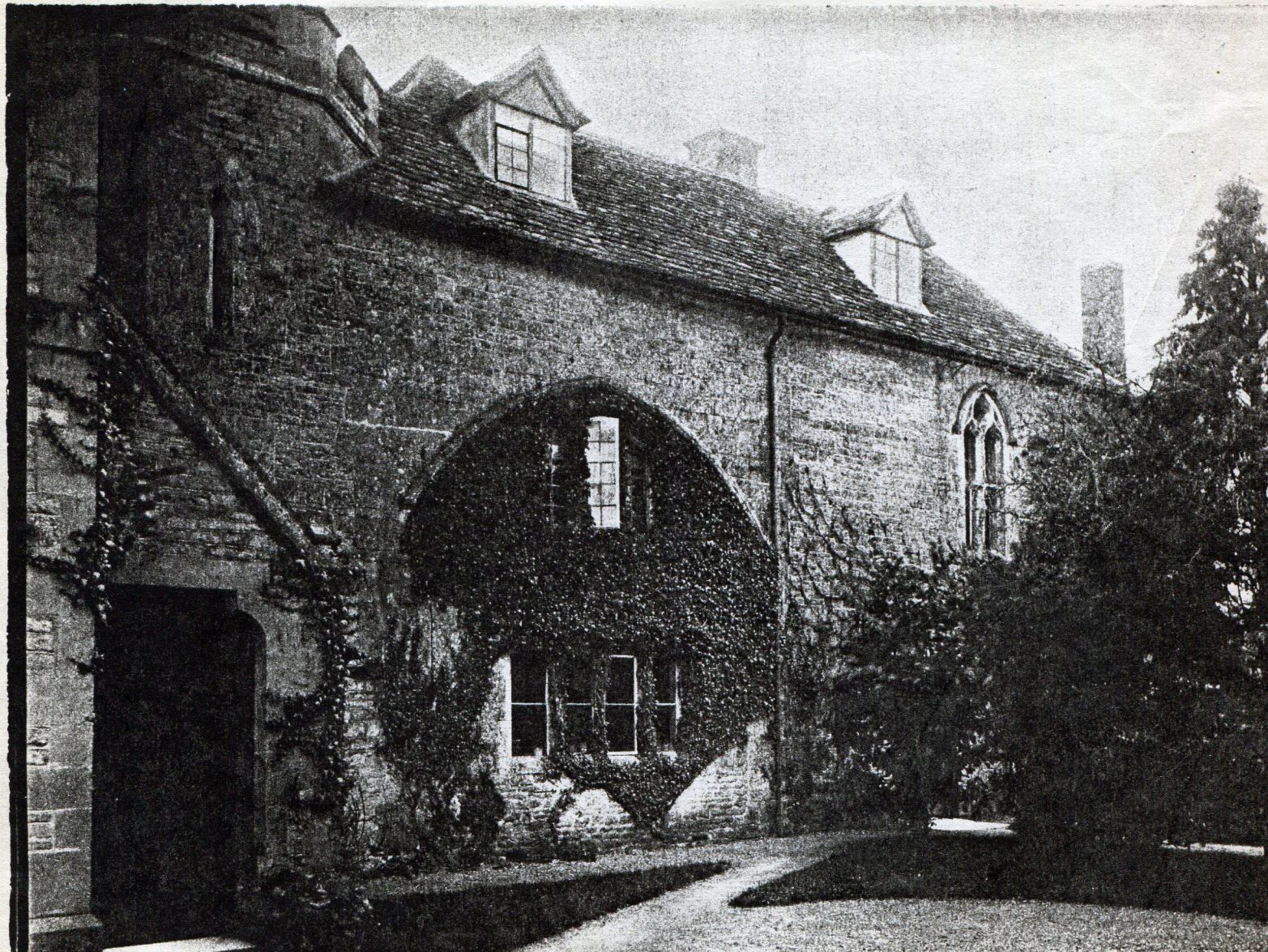


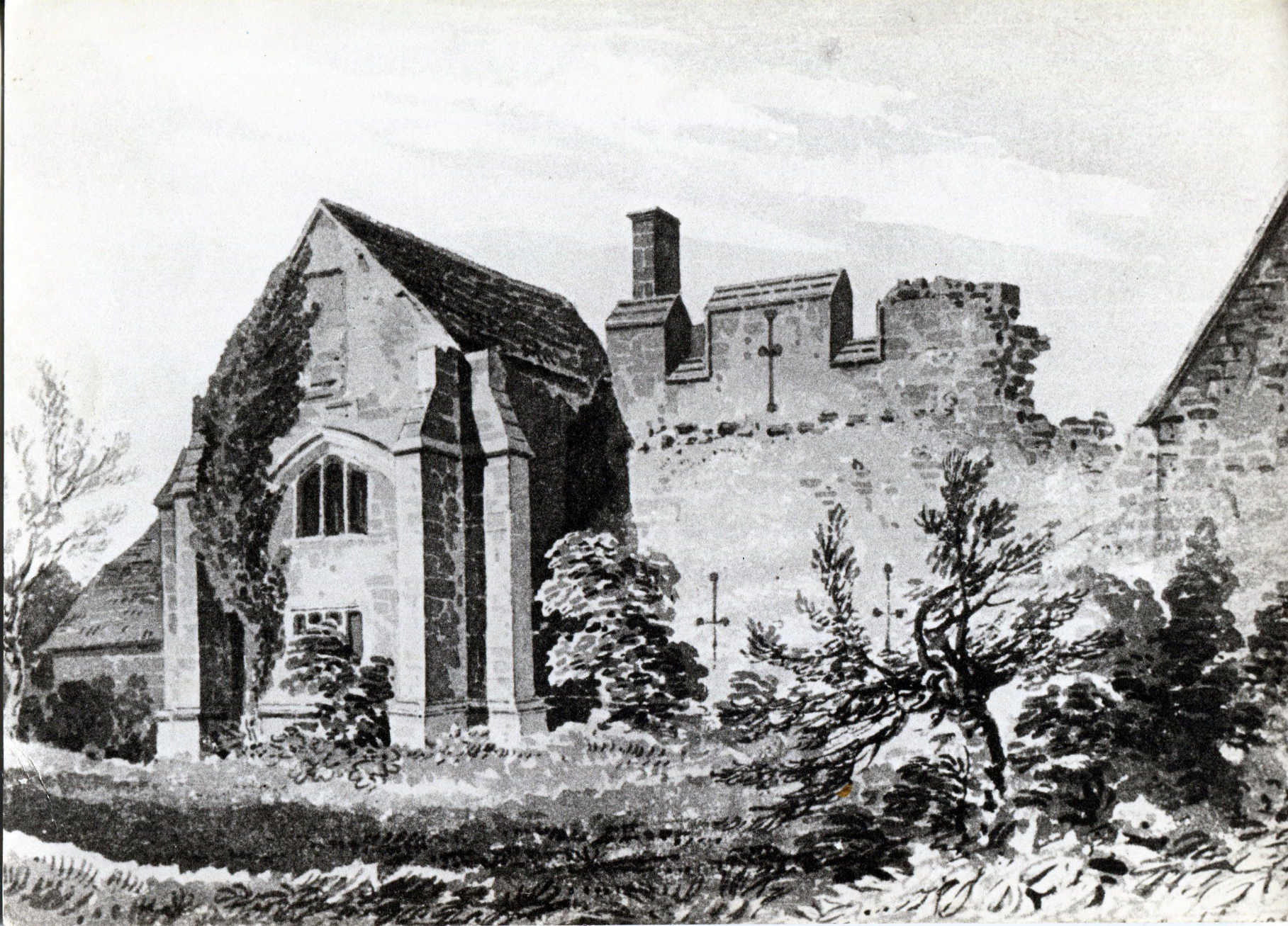




















One, Wm Lynghwood a Norfolk carpenter worked
