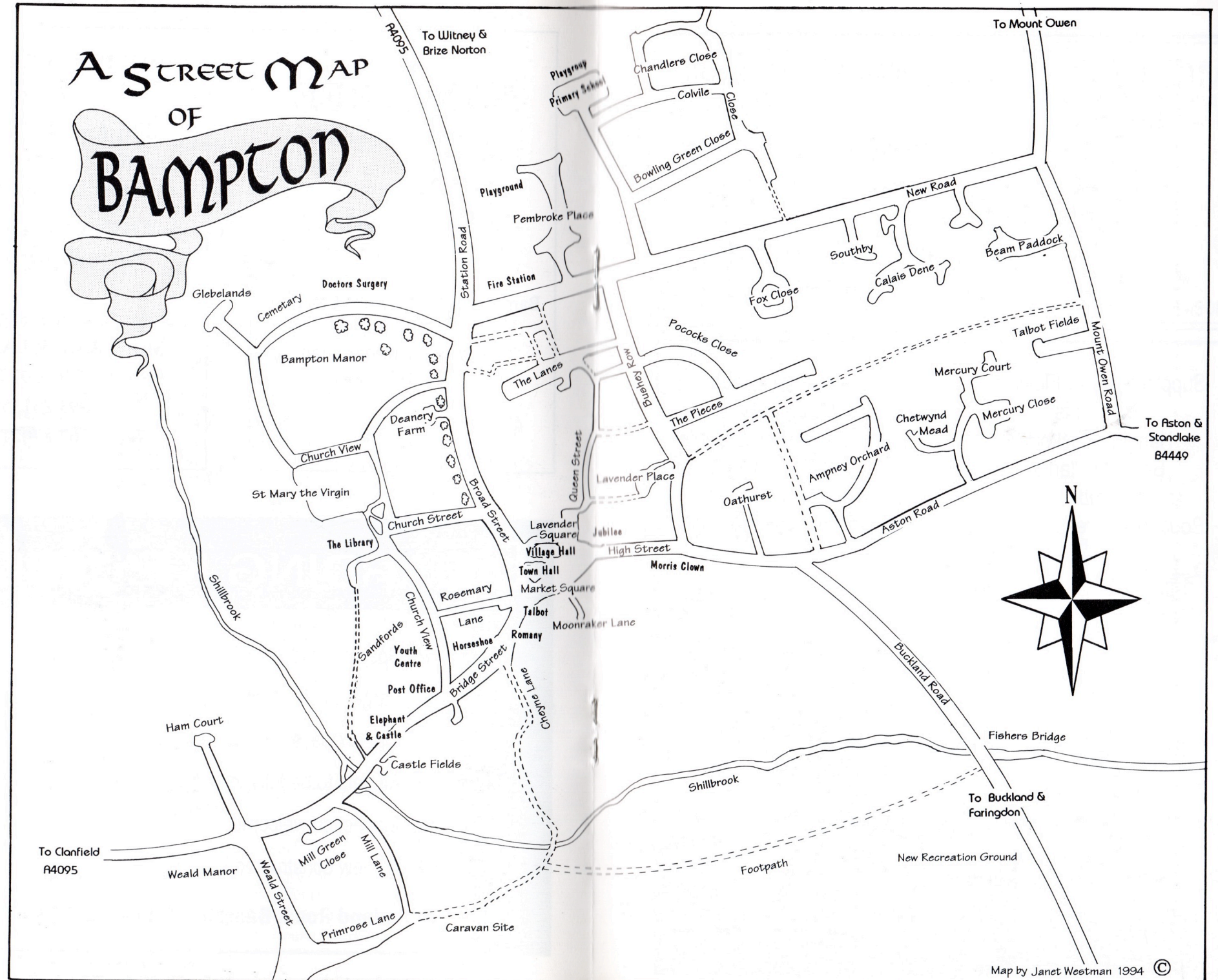

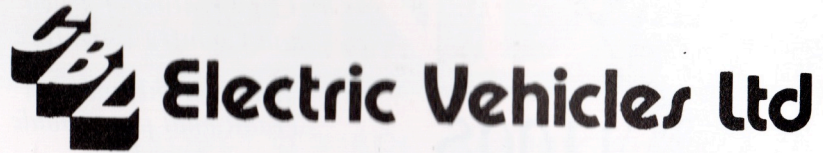




# A STREET MAP OF BAMPTON
