BAMPTON HORTICULTURAL SOCIETY

- The name of The Society shall be known as 'The Bampton Horticultural Society'.
- 2. The objects of The Society shall be the re-introduction of the Bampton Flower Show' and the encouragement of Horticulture generally.
- 3. The Committee shall have the power to frame such regulations as they think necessary for each Show and such regulations shall form part of the Schedule. All matters not provided for in these regulations shall be left to the discretion of the Committee whose decision shall be final.
- Subscriptions. Members shall pay an annual subscription, the amount to be decided annually. The subscription for 1980 will be 35p. Senior Citizens 10p.

RULES FOR EXHIBITORS

- 1. Exhibits must be the property of the exhibitor unless otherwise stated, all exhibits must have been in their possession for at least two months.
- 2. Any prize may be withheld or modified if the exhibits are considered unworthy of the prize offered, or insufficient number of entries tabled.
- 3. All exhibits to be staged 12.00 2.00 p.m. unless otherwise stated.
- 4. Only one entry per Class to each exhibitor.
- 5. The Six Heaviest Pumpkins to be retained by the Society until their Competition with Standlake and Cumnor are ended, after which, they will be returned to their respective owners.

PLEASE NOTE:

All entry forms to be entered with the Secretary on the printed form, on or before Thursday, August 7 th 9.00 p.m. for the Main Show and Thursday October 2 nd 9.00 p.m. for the Autumn Show.

LATE ENTRIES WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED

Entries can be handed in at the Town Hall Thursday 7 th August, and Thursday 2 nd October, between 6.00 p.m. and 9.00 p.m.

No 1st Prize will be awarded unless there are at least two exhibits. No 2nd Prize will be awarded unless there are at least three exhibits. No 3rd Prize will be awarded unless there are at least four exhibits.
