

Cllr Alaric Smith has been campaigning to ensure that the new Local Plan contains realistic and deliverable housing targets, with an infrastructure first approach.


The Conservative housing numbers put into the current Local Plan have led to the threat of speculative (unplanned) development to our local community.

The Lib Dem team are calling for more affordable housing, and proper infrastructure.


Cllr Smith has also been working with residents who want to make their local streets safer.

# Taking ACTION on sewage


West Oxfordshire is one of the worst affected areas in the country for sewage discharges, with Thames Water routinely dumping sewage into the Shill Brook at Bampton and the Marsh Lane Ditch at Clanfield, as well as into the Windrush and the Evenlode.

The new Lib Dem-led district council is holding regular meetings with Thames Water, to press for a programme of action to reduce and eventually end these discharges.

Cllr Alaric Smith, who is a member of the team of Councillors involved in the meetings, said: "This problem has arisen as a result of excessive profit-taking by Thames Water over a prolonged period, inadequate regulation, and years of inaction and complacency from the previous Tory administration." So far, Thames Water has launched an interactive map which shows in real time where they are spilling untreated sewage, and has completed sewer-lining work in Clanfield. They have also set out plans to upgrade the Sewage Treatment Plants at Bampton, Witney and Church Hanborough.

In the case of Bampton, this investment has been brought forward from Thames Water's Asset Management Plan 2025-2030 and should be completed by the end of 2024.


In the meantime, Robert Courts MP voted **AGAINST** an amendment to the Environment Act, which attempted to impose a meaningful timetable for the ending of dumping of raw sewage. Along with the Conservative government, he is letting water companies off the hook.

# Reconnect Carterton, Witney, Eynsham and Oxford by rail

## Lib Dem Charlie Maynard is leading the campaign

The campaign to reinstate the rail line linking Carterton, Witney and Eynsham with Oxford is rolling.

The project has been led by Lib Dem parliamentary candidate, Charlie Maynard, who is also Chair of the cross-party Witney Oxford Transport Group.

Charlie has been working hard on the project, carrying out a survey showing that 97% of more than 800 West Oxfordshire residents supported a feasibility study being conducted. The Lib Dem-led county council has funded a feasibility study which will be completed around the end of March. Network Rail is a strong supporter of the project.

Rail can provide a fast, green, reliable transport solution, something the A40 certainly isn't.

Journey time savings will be up to 70% with Oxford being reachable from Carterton in 22 minutes, from Witney in 16 mins and Eynsham in just 9 mins.
