Well, I'm afraid all I can offer is the enclosed copies of photographs which were taken of Dad and his 'machines'. I'm not sure where the '3' are taken,

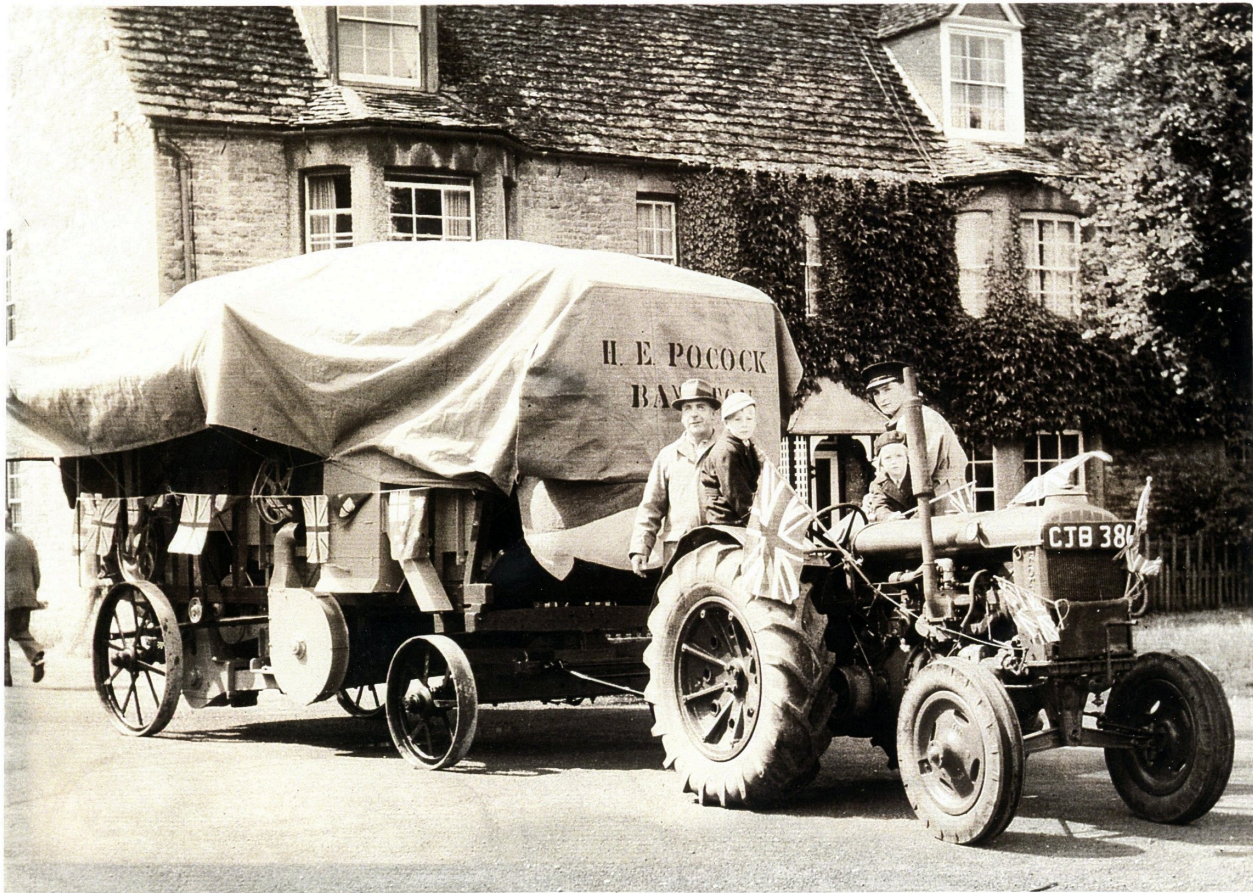
but the 'carnival' one was taken
