AS THIS LOVELY WEATHER CONTINUES AND APRIL IS ALMOST UPON US, WE WILL LEAVE YOU WITH SOME GARDENING TIPS FOR THE MONTH AHEAD:

YOUR LAWN

- IF YOU ARE SOWING A NEW LAWN, APRIL IS THE RIGHT TIME FOR SPRING SOWING
- YOU MAY WANT TO DETHATCH EXISTING LAWNS TO HELP THE SOIL BREATHE
- APPLY FERTILISER TO YOUR LAWN, FOR A BOOST AT THE START OF THE SEASON
- START MOWING YOUR LAWN REGULARLY
- IF YOU HAVE A PATCH WHERE DAFFODILS, CROCUS OR SNOWDROPS POPPED UP, REFRAIN FROM MOWING THERE

UNTIL LATER IN THE SEASON, IN ORDER TO GIVE BULBS TIME TO RECOVER NUTRIENTS FOR NEXT SPRING

IN YOUR PERENNIAL BOARDERS

- THIS IS THE TIME TO GET ON TOP OF YOUR WEED SITUATION BEFORE THEY RUN OUT OF CONTROL!
- LIFT AND DIVIDE PERENNIAL PLANTS NOW TO IMPROVE VIGOUR AND CREATE NEW PLANTS FOR YOUR GARDEN

TREES, SHRUBS AND ROSES

- FEED SHRUBS AND ROSES WITH SLOW-RELEASE FERTILISER BY LIGHTLY FORKING IT INTO THE SOIL SURFACE
- APRIL IS STILL A GOOD TIME TO PLANT ANY REMAINING CONTAINER-BOUGHT TREES, SHRUBS AND ROSES THAT ARE STILL IN THEIR POTS. REMEMBER TO WATER GENEROUSLY ESPECIALLY IF THE WEATHER STARTS TO WARM

IN THE VEGETABLE GARDEN

- PREPARE VEGETABLE SEED BEDS BY REMOVING ALL WEEDS
- DIG IN A LAYER OF COMPOST, WELL-ROTTED MANURE OR GREEN WASTE INTO YOUR BEDS
- KEEP BEDS DAMP IN PREPARATION FOR THE BULK OF YOUR SOWING



WE HOPE YOU ARE ALL STAYING SAFE AND WE WISH YOU ALL THE
VERY BEST. TAKE CARE OUT THERE.
