One of 25 newcomers is Mary Robinson, of West End, Witney, who is studying for A-level art at Witney technical college. Her bold study of a trunk on the landing at home brought the admiration of Mr Anthony Baynes, chairman of the association's art panel.

"Year by year the standards and the number of exhibitors goes on rising," he said.

The exhibition is closed on Mondays and Wednesdays and goes on until March 3.
